 - (one person in our group talked about philanthropy somewhere like this in Longmont). In the future when things are back to normal would love to do more and get more involved, but kind of hard right now.
 - Maybe OoO has its own philanthropy and could host activities/service events for that philanthropy. If we have a common goal and common philanthropy people may take it more seriously and be more involved. Would love to help out even more within the CSU community
 - More involvement within FSL on campus (which could also act as a way to get information about OoO to other members of Greek organizations),

find some ways to do volunteer programs within the Fort Collins community (ex: mentorship programs)

- How many hours are you willing to dedicate toward Order of Omega?
 - 1 event outside meetings per month (10 hours a semester including meetings, service events)
 - 1 hour biweekly (having flexibility is important, and being able to do it on your own time also is important)

 - What expectations do you believe that members of Order of Omega should uphold?
 - Required to attend at least one leadership or professional development meeting per semester (whether through OoO or through sorority/fraternity), minimum GPA requirement, possibly reduce requirements due to COVID
 - Be in good standing with your chapter and academics. Maybe a GPA requirement? Hard to say that this semester because everyone is already so stressed and hybrid/online is difficult, but in the future this could work. In a normal semester, (not crazy COVID semester) could have a leadership or professional development requirement, but would like to have options for this (ie attend a leadership seminar/workshop, hold a leadership position, etc.)
 - Providing a list of possible community service to do for members to achieve those hours outside of their chapters - Setting a dollar amount to raise money for a specific organization that can translate into hours -Having a community list of possible CSU events to commit too
 - Being honest and having integrity talking about academics, especially if you're struggling in classes. Make time to participate, we signed up to be involved with this also Being respectful while also giving an environment that people can share their opinions
